Dear Sir / Ma'am:

Pursuant to a court ordered Risk Protection Order our records indicate that you are ineligible to possess a firearm.

Connecticut General Statutes Section § 29-36k further requires that immediately or within 24 hours of the occurrence of any event that makes you ineligible you:

1. **Deliver or surrender** any/all firearms and ammunition to any local police department, Connecticut State Police Troop — not to include Troop W (Bradley Int. Airport) or Headquarters in Middletown.

You may transfer the firearms to a Federal Firearms Licensed dealer after your first court appearance. Once the court order is terminated, the firearms will only be kept at the local police department or Connecticut State Police Troop for 6 months, at which point the firearms may be destroyed.

You are hereby ordered to comply with the requirements of these statutes immediately. Criminal Possession of a Firearm is a felony and non-compliance may result in prosecution.

NOTE: You must immediately notify this office at (860) 685-8285, and the police department in the jurisdiction where you reside that you have completed the required surrender. Upon surrendering your firearms, you are required to supply this office with a receipt from the Connecticut State Police Troop or local police department where the surrender was made. This letter authorizes you to transport the firearms and ammunition without a permit solely for the purpose of allowing you to comply with your obligation to surrender them.

Dear Sir / Ma'am:

Your "Permit to Carry Pistols or Revolvers" is revoked, effective immediately, as a result of your involvement in an incident investigated by: Branford Police Department, Case Number RISKWARRANT2400016391, Date: 11/13/2024.

If you still have possession of the permit, Connecticut General Statutes Section 29-32, requires that you return said permit to the Connecticut State Police Special Licensing & Firearms Unit, 1111, Country Club Road, Middletown, CT 06457-9294.

If for any reason you no longer possess the permit (or any duplicate permits), you must submit a written, notarized statement that states:

- (1) You are aware the permit is revoked.
- (2) The reason you are unable to return the permit.
- (3) If for any reason you locate the permit, you will return it immediately to the Connecticut State Police Firearms Unit.

You MUST do this even if your permit was confiscated by the State Police or a municipal police agency. Any such confiscation must be reported to this office.

Per CGS 29-32, any person who fails to surrender such permit within five (5) days of receipt of this notification shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor.

To appeal this revocation, contact The Board of Firearms Permit Examiners, State Office Bldg. 165 Capitol Ave., Suite 1070, Hartford, CT 06106 (Tel. 860-256-2947). You have ninety (90) days from the receipt of this letter in which to file such an appeal. As your appeal right will lapse at the end of ninety days, it is recommended that you protect this right by contacting the Board no matter what the circumstances of this revocation might be.

I understand that any statement(s) made herein, which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his/her official function is a crime under Connecticut General Statutes §53a-157b and is punishable by law.

On the above date and time, I met with Trooper / Officer Casey McCone (name) of the Branford (Police Department) at 33 Laurel St. Branford, CT (location) to provide the following statement: I have been informed by:

- A letter received from the Connecticut State Police, Special Licensing and Firearms Unit dated _____.
- A judge, prosecutor or other official at Superior Court GA- _____ (town).
- Trooper / Officer Casey McCone (name) of Branford Police Department.
- Other source (describe) _____

that pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Sections 53a-217 and/or 53a-217c as amended by P.A. 16-34, I am *ineligible* to possess firearms and/or ammunition.

I understand that if I am subject to a protective or restraining order, or a foreign order of protection, my firearms and ammunition may only be (1) transferred to a federally licensed firearms dealer; or (2) surrendered to the Connecticut State Police or to a local police department. This action must be taken immediately and under no circumstances later than twenty-four (24) hours after notice has been provided to me that I am subject to one of the above orders. I understand that if I am ineligible to possess firearms and/or ammunition for any other reason, I may either transfer the firearm(s) and/or ammunition in my possession to some other person that is eligible to possess them or surrender them to the Connecticut State Police or to a local police department no later than two (2) business days after becoming ineligible. If I transfer the firearm(s) and/or ammunition, I must comply with Connecticut General Statutes Section 29-36k as amended by P.A. 16-34 and any other state or federal statutes.

If I have a Connecticut permit to carry pistols or revolvers or an eligibility certificate or temporary state permit that has been revoked, I understand that I have five (5) days from receipt of notification in writing that the permit has been revoked, to surrender the permit to the Connecticut State Police.

To comply with the above requirements, I have:
